□ Entrance Test Financial Aid	-SAT: Writing = 440, Reading = 440, Math = 440 acceptable, 250 preferred. -ACT: English = 17, Reading = 18, Math 19 acceptable, 23 preferred -PERT (only available in Florida): English 99, Reading 104 and Math 123
